Remarks by Ambassador Zhang Weidong at the Annual General Meeting of ICCS 2017-10-17

Distinguished Chairperson, Dear friends, ladies and gentlemen,

Good evening!

Thank you very much for inviting me and my colleague to the Annual General Meeting of Icelandic Chinese Cultural Society (ICCS or KIM). First of all I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate Mrs. Gudrun Margret Thrastardottir for being elected as the new chairperson of ICCS.

Elin, his wife, is called the "中国永远的情人" (eternal fiancé of China). She has also done a lot for our friendship. We highly appreciate your efforts and cherish your friendship with China. I am sure you will continue to give your insights and support to the work of the ICCS in the future. I wish you all the best.

Mrs. Gudrun Margret Thrastardottir is the first female chairperson of ICCS. But she is not new to us at all. She has been very active in doing a lot to help the work in the ICCS, making contributions to deepen our friendship. I wish her a great success. The Chinese embassy will closely cooperate with her.

Ladies and gentlemen,

China values its friendship with Iceland and deems Iceland a reliable, good friend and partner in Europe. In the past three years, China-Iceland relations have been stable and move forward step by step. The high level exchanges have been closer, political trust has been deepened and personnel exchanges in all aspects have been enhanced. Our cooperation in the fields of economy, trade, culture and Arctic affairs are productive, which have brought tangible benefits to our two peoples.

The 19th National Congress of the Communist Party of China (CPC) will convene in Beijing tomorrow. The Congress is convened when China enters the decisive stage in accomplishing the building of a moderately prosperous society in all respects and the crucial period of the development of socialism with Chinese characteristics. The Congress will review the Party's work over the past five years and draw the blue-print for development of the CPC and China in coming five years and beyond. It will also lay out China's plan for its future international cooperation, which will have a major bearing on China-Iceland relations.

I will finish my tenure as Chinese Ambassador and leave Iceland early next month. This is the last time for me to come to your annual general meeting. The past more than 1,100 days have left me with many sweet memories. I am blessed to have made so many friends from different walks of life including all the members of ICCS. I wish all the members of the ICCS will make consistent efforts and work together with all sides to advance China-Iceland relations to a new stage. My colleagues in the embassy and my successor, no matter who, will render supports to you as usual. I also hope you will provide as much help as you have been kindly providing me to my successor when he arrives, and during the transition, to my good friend, the Charge d'affaires and Councilor, Mr. Zhong Xuhui.
